



Urban Indians and Colorectal Cancer

Support Public Awareness & Education. Make screening a priority. Target Health Disparities.

- Save Money:** Individuals who are uninsured and underinsured are less likely to get screened, are more likely to be diagnosed at an advanced stage of CRC, and less likely to survive than those who are insured. Promote early screening and save millions in estimated Medicare costs as the U.S. population ages.
- Save Lives:** When diagnosed early, colon cancer has a five-year survival rate of 90%. Colonoscopies can identify and remove pre-cancerous cells before cancer begins.
- Save Time:** Work with Urban Indian Health Organizations (UIHO) to help overcome barriers to care. UIHOs have culturally appropriate and community-trusted patient management services in place that can be utilized to implement colorectal cancer screening for Urban Indians.
- Reduce Health Disparities:** American Indians and Alaska Natives are a priority population to target for colorectal cancer because they are more often diagnosed with advanced rather than early stage CRC. Cancer survival data reveal that AI/ANs have the poorest survival of any racial group for all cancer sites combined and for eight of the ten leading sites.

Remember to include Tribal and Urban Indian Health Organizations in CRC planning efforts, policies, and programs in your state.
